

Remarks On Board *U.S.S. Mary & Susan* Capt. L. C. Owens 1887
Wednesday Aug. 11th

Commenced with a strong breeze from ESE B³ laying at anchor middle part a fresh breeze from N. W. Sea coming in at 1 P.M. took our anchor and commenced to work to the S between the Sea and Land Sea in 6 fathoms water. Latter part Wind the same B³ Anchored in Pearl Bay hands employed in Boiling and Stowing down so ends

Thursday 12th
Commenced with a strong breeze from N. W. B³ laying at anchor at 8.30 took our anchor and worked up under the Star Wars Islands in 5 1/2 fathoms water and let go middle part Wind more moderate took our anchor and worked in to 17 feet water and let go Sea coming in latter part a light air from N. W. B³ at anchor hands employed in Boiling and Stowing down so ends

Friday 13th
Commenced with a light air from N. W. B³ laying at anchor middle part a calm latter part a fine breeze from NE B³ heading to the N. W. at 1.30 took our anchor and commenced to make to the N through the Sea hands employed in Stowing down and Boiling so ends

Saturday 14th
Commenced with a fine breeze from NE B³ laying on different tack middle and latter part the same hands employed in Stowing down and Boiling Ship so ends

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Sunday Aug. 14th

Commenced with a strong breeze from N. W. B³ laying on different tack middle part a fresh breeze from NE B³ working to the N. W. latter part a fresh breeze from ESE B³ working to the N. W. so ends

Monday 15th
Commenced with a fresh breeze from ESE B³ working to the N. W. middle part the same with Rain at 11 A.M. came to anchor in 6 fathoms water ahead of Cape Smyth. Latter wind from the same quarter with Rain hands employed in Ship's duty so ends

Tuesday 16th
Commenced with a light breeze from N. W. B³ laying at anchor middle part a calm with fog latter part a light air from N. W. B³ working to the N. W. hands employed in Ship's duty so ends

Wednesday 17th
Commenced with a strong breeze from NE B³ laying at anchor in 10 fathoms middle part Wind the same at 1 P.M. got under weigh and worked up to Point Barrow and Anchored again latter part Wind the same B³ still at anchor hands employed in Ship's duty so ends

Thursday 18th
Commenced with a fine breeze from NE B³ laying at anchor under Point Barrow middle part a calm with fog latter part a fine breeze from NE B³ working to the E hands employed in Ship's duty so ends
