

Remarks On board *U.S.S. Mary Susan* Capt. L. C. Owens 1887

Thursday Sept 5th

Commenced with a fine breeze from N.E. B^{rs} laying on different tacks middle part wind the same with fog B^{rs} steering to the S.W. along the coast latter part wind the same B^{rs} working to the S.W. hands employed in ship's duty as usual

Friday 6th

Commenced with a fine breeze with fog from N.E. B^{rs} laying on different tacks middle part the same latter part wind the same B^{rs} steering to the S.W. hands employed in ship's duty as usual

Saturday 10th

Commenced with a fine breeze from N.E. B^{rs} laying on different tacks middle part a light air from N.E. and a calm B^{rs} steering to the N. latter part a light air from S.W. steering N.W. by N. hands employed in ship's duty as usual

Sunday 11th

Commenced with a fine breeze from S.W. B^{rs} laying on different tacks middle part the same with some squalls B^{rs} steering from N.W. by N. to N. by S. at 2 P.M. passed Herald Island bearing N. $\frac{1}{2}$ E distance about 30 miles at dark Island bearing S.W. $\frac{1}{2}$ W distance 10 miles latter part wind the same B^{rs} laying on different tacks as usual

Monday 12th

Commenced with a fine breeze from S.W. laying on different tacks middle part a calm with rain and fog latter part a calm with fog saw a whale going quick to the N. Island bearing S.W. distance 20 miles hands employed in ship's duty as usual

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Tuesday Sept 13th

Commenced with a calm with fog middle part a fine breeze from S.W. on different tacks at 1.30 P.M. covered for whales. I Row Boat struck and got on latter part a strong breeze from N.W. B^{rs} heading N.E. hands employed cutting

Wednesday 14th

Commenced with a fine breeze from N.W. B^{rs} heading N.E. middle part a calm latter part a light air from N.W. heading E.N.E. hands employed in boiling so ends

Thursday 15th

Commenced with a calm middle part a fine breeze from N.W. B^{rs} on different tacks Louisburg Island bearing S.W. $\frac{1}{2}$ E distance 15 miles latter part a light air from S.W. by S. B^{rs} on different tacks hands employed in boiling so ends

Friday 16th

Commenced with a light air from N.W. B^{rs} laying on different tacks middle part a strong breeze from S.W. working to the S.W. latter part a strong breeze from S.W. heading S. hands employed in boiling and blowing down main hold so ends

Saturday 17th

Commenced with a light air S.W. working to the S.W. middle part a fine breeze with rain from N.W. heading E.N.E. latter part wind the same with fog B^{rs} heading E.N.E. hands employed in blowing and cleaning up so ends
