

Remarks On board 3rd rank Susan Capt. L. C. Owens 1867
Tuesday 27th Sept.

Commenced with a strong breeze from NNE B^o heading to the E later
middle of fresh breeze from NNE B^o heading to the E later
part blowing a light Sals from NNE B^o heading to the
SE W^o hands employed in boiling and stowing down
Tins Hold at 11 AM Coaled down so ends

Wednesday 28th

Commenced with a Sals from NNE B^o heading to the E
middle and latter part the same hands employed in
Ship's duty so ends

Thursday 29th

Commenced with a Sals from NNE B^o heading to the E middle part
the same latter part Wind the same B^o heading to the NNE hands
employed in Ship's duty so ends

Friday 30th

Commenced with a Sals from NNE B^o heading to the E middle part
the same latter part a Sals from NNE B^o heading to the E hands em-
ployed in Ship's duty so ends

Saturday Oct 1st

Commenced with a heavy Sals from NNE middle and latter part
the same B^o laying under lower main top sail heading to
the E. so ends

Sunday Oct 2nd

Commenced with a heavy Sals from NNE B^o heading to the E at 11 AM
left off SE by S middle part and latter a fresh breeze from NNE B^o steering SE by S
at 3 PM started the works so ends

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Monday Oct 3rd

Commenced with a fresh breeze from NNE B^o heading to the E at 11 AM left
off SE by S middle part Wind the same at 12 PM passed East Cape
at 5 PM anchored under North Head latter part 4 PM the
same B^o laying at anchor in 7 fathoms water hands employed
in boiling and stowing down so ends

Tuesday 4th

Commenced with a Sals from NNE B^o laying at anchor middle and
latter part the same hands employed in boiling and stowing
down so ends

Wednesday 5th

Commenced with a fine breeze from NNE B^o laying at anchor at 11 AM took
our anchor and steered to the S middle part Wind the same B^o
steering to the SE at dark shifted too heading to the E latter
part Wind the same B^o heading to the E hands employed in boiling
and stowing down Ship's Hold so ends

Thursday 6th

Commenced with a fresh breeze from NNE B^o laying on different tack
at 6.30 left off SE at 11 AM anchored under Indian Point in 7
fathoms water and discharged our stores middle part Steaming
a Sals from NNE at 1.30 PM took our anchor and steered
SE by S latter part Wind the same B^o steering the same
hands employed in Ship's duty so ends
Orca, Sea, Boats, and Schooner, Ino in company
