at 7 P M Anton Romeo Sick off duty  
Employed in General Ship duty and setting  
up shrouds between decks. This day  
So ends this day

hauling into North East at 7 P M heading  
course North West by 1/2 North No ice in  
sight Employed in coiling & small  
Libs of line overhauling lead line Reving  
new signals Halcyards and General Ship  
duty Plenty of finbacks in sight  
Anton Romeo Sick off duty So ends this day

Friday April 6"

begins with a light breeze from the S. E.  
BK heading course N. W. 1/2 W 6 am 4 sails  
in sight at 9 am Picked up drifter  
Wind N N W BK heading S W Middle Part  
Tacked ship at 12.30 m heading N at  
1.30 P M Spoke BK bounding Bulow Capt.  
Ludlow came aboard and brought Native  
Peter aboard is very Sick Tacked at 2.30  
P M BK heading S W latter Part wind  
N BK heading W N W So ends this day  
Lat" 60.05. N  
Long" 177.33. E

Saturday April 7"

begins with a light breeze from N E  
BK heading N N W. under lower  
Topsails Head yards aback Spoke BK  
Eliza Capt. Kelly aboard and got caught  
of 1 bunch of Irons and 8 Darting Gun  
Middle & latter Part Spoke BK Wanderer  
Capt. Winslow came aboard. at 7 P M  
heading N N E wind baffling  
Native very Sick Anton Romeo  
Still off duty Sick So ends this day  
Lat" 60.05. N  
Long" 177.24. E

Sunday April 8"

begins with a light breeze from E to N. E. BK  
heading N N W Middle & latter Part the  
young ice around us as far as the  
eye can see 4 Bks in sight So ends this day

Lat" 60.09. N  
Long" 177.15. E
