Begins with light breeze from W.W.W Bk
on Port Tack heading to the north middle
Port the same latter Port Wind E N E Bk
heading to the north on Starboard Tack
at 7 A.M. buried Esquimaux Peter
4 Barks in Sight Employed in General
Ships duty Broke out 1 Bk Port at 8 P.M.
Laying on opposite Tacks So Ends this day
Lat "60.10. N
Long" 177.16. E

Begins with a light Gale from the East
Bk under lower Topsails Laying in the ice
on opposite Tacks Middle & Latter Part
The same Gained Bk Bounding Billow
Capt Snellow 4 Bks in Sight

This day Lat "60.30. N
Long" 177.38. E

Thursday April 12"

Begins with an East Wind Middle & Latter
Part the same Bk Laying too with fore
Yards Square along the edge of the ice
on opposite Tacks Spoke Bk Wanderer
Bounding Billow and Wm Baylis three sails
in sight to the west in the Pack and
1 to the south So Ends this day

Friday 13th

Begins with a light breeze from the S E
with snow squalls Middle & Latter Part
Wind East and clear lying too under
short sail on opposite Tacks Spoke
Bk Wanderer Bounding Billow young Phoenix
and William Baylis brought aboard
Patey & Mike from young Phoenix Two
Esquimaux Employed in Hooking Rudder
Gear Shifting Spar and General Ships duty
9 Bk in Sight So Ends this day
