Begins with a light breeze with flow from E.S.E. Middle Port Calm and clear latter Port a fine breeze from N.W.E. BK working along the Rack with fog at the last 4 BK 1 Stmr & 2 Schrs in sight - BK Ocean 4 Boats down for cow & calf Bowhead with out success So End this day.

Monday May 21st

Begins with a light breeze from E.N.E. with a thick fog BK working into the S & N. along the Rack see Middle & Latter Port lying in heavy fogs aback thick fog spoke B Hidalgo and BK J.A. Bowland Employed in breaking out 600 Gall Fresh water and refilling with salt water & General Ships duty So End this day

Tuesday May 22nd

Begins with a light breeze from E.N.E. with a thick fog Middle & Latter Port Wind N.E. with clearing weather BK working along the Rack see looking for a chance to get a whale or a lead into St Lawrence Island 9 Sails in sight - Employed in General Ships duty spoke BK's Abram Barker Standen Ohio & Eliza Soundings 20 Fathoms

Tuesday May 27

Begins with a strong breeze from N.W.W BK working into the North Middle Port the Wind the same latter Port thick fog for 2 hours Wind & clearing into N.W. by N Employed hauling cable forward and hauling up 15 Fathoms on Portland cable and getting Sail Room ready. Masinkes 9 Sails in sight St Lawrence Island and Place Bay in sight at 6.30. N. Long 172.18 W

Wednesday May 28th

Begins with a strong breeze from N.W.E BK working to the N Middle and Latter Port the same and blowing a moderate Gale Flood. To N Head Flow. Bay at 3 Pm at 4.30 Am saw a Bow head going quick to windward lowered 2 Boats but came aboard at 8 Am with out success Employed in breaking out 1000 beef and General Ships duty So End this day

Thursday May 29th

Begins with a strong Gale from N by E. BK working along the land to the N.W. Middle Port the same latter Port moderating anchored at 5 Pm South of Indian Point in 7 1/2 fathoms of water Employed in General Ships duty
