Eliza Kelly clear 10 PM calm West Head
Plover Bay Bearing N distant 10 miles
So ends this day.

Thursday June 14th

Begins with a light breeze from S. W. BK
Heading N. N. W. anchored at 10 P.M. under
West Head Plover Bay in 11 fathoms water
Middle Port all boats off cruising aboard at
5 P.M. nothing seen anything west & Starboard
Boats off cruising latter Port Starboard and west
Boats cruising So ends this day

Friday June 15th

Begins at anchor at West Head Plover Bay
Boats cruising watch and watch 10 BK in
sight nothing in sight So ends this
day

Saturday June 23rd

This day begins with calm light air
from N. N. W. At 7 A.M. got under way
BK working to the north Middle and latter
Port light and baffling winds from N. W.
to N. N. E. BK's working north 15 BKs in
sight - Hands employed in ships duty

Sunday June 24th

Begins with a light breeze from N. N. W. BK's
working to the north Middle Port the the same
latter Port strong breeze from N. N. E. BK's lying
aback along the ice of South Head & Lawrence
Bay 8 P.M. South Head N. N. W. distant
7 miles Hands Employed Ships duty

Monday June 25th

Begins with a strong breeze from N. BK's working
to the N. Middle Port BK on Eastward tack
latter Port BK lying with head yard aback
Thoke Fog 9 PM clear Wind N. N. W.
BK on Eastward tack Diomedes Islands
bearing north distant 15 miles Hands Employed
in Ships duty So ends this day
