- Monday
Dec 18 fair weather throughout the day employ setting up
Shocks. And to the fresh Beef.
- Tuesday
Dec 19 light variable winds and fair weather,
employ setting up Shocks and at other jobs
- Wednesday
Dec 20 moderate southerly winds, latter part cloudy
with some rain. employ setting up Shocks
got the Dy. yard on Deck and fitted the Bands
- Thursday
Dec 21 moderate variable winds unsettled weather with
some rain. P.M. commenced breaking out
oil. at night W. Wood and J. Sullivan, Descent
from the ship.
- Friday
Dec 22 fair weather throughout the day. A.M. hauled
alongside of the ship Nor Wester. P.M. employ
Starting water out of Pipes and fitting them to some
oil home in.
- Saturday
Dec 23 fair weather throughout the day. employ
Breaking out and putting oil on Board the
Ship Nor Wester. Recd 6 Casks from Shore
to send oil in. hired three labourers.
- Sunday
Dec 24 A.M. fair weather. P.M. strong southerly
winds and stormy. so ends
- Monday
Dec 25 most part fair weather. employ Discharging
oil on Board of the N. Wester.
- Tuesday
Dec 26 southerly winds with some rain.
employ discharging oil on Board the
Nor Wester.

Wednesday
Dec 27 A.M. fair weather. P.M. Rainy, unsettled weather,
employ Discharging oil. so ends

Thursday
Dec 28 fair weather throughout the day at 2 P.M. finished
Discharging oil. latter part employ hauling and
Moring Ship. during the night three of the crew
Deserted. - viz, J. Crampin. - R. Munsell, and
J. Ogden.

Friday
Dec 29 fair weather throughout the day. employ
Scalding out Ground tier Casks. and stowing them
down. Discharged Mr. Forbush. the Second Mate.

Saturday
Dec 30 A.M. fair weather. P.M. Cloudy and Rainy weather.
employ scalding out Casks. stowing and filling
water. &c

Sunday
Dec 31st most part strong breezes from S.E.
cloudy and stormy weather.

Monday
Jan 1st 1851 all these 24 hours Cloudy and stormy weather.
most part strong southerly winds.

Tuesday
Jan 2nd strong southerly winds, cloudy, unsettled weather
with some rain. P.M. stowed a few
Ground tier Casks and filled with water.

Wednesday
Jan 3rd Cloudy unsettled weather throughout. P.M. stormy
with strong S.W. wind. A.M. employ stowing
Ground tier and filling water.

Thursday
Jan 4th most part cloudy, unsettled weather. employ
filling water. Recd two Casks from Shore.
Mr. Pursons on Board at work.
Henry Bluff Deserted this day.
