

Friday March 16<sup>th</sup> 1855.  
mostly moderate breezes from the Eastward and fair weather. employed variously. A.M. sent ashore 9 casks for water. P.M. got a Raft of 12 casks on Board, so ends.

Saturday March 17<sup>th</sup>  
most part fair weather. moderate breeze from E to S. got off a Raft of 15 casks water, and 2 Boat loads of wood. Broke out After hold for a Cask of Powder, opened a Cask of Bread.

Sunday March 17<sup>th</sup> 1855  
A.M. fine weather. P.M. squally with Rain took up the small Hedge, and put out the heavy one. opened a tier of Beef at Port.

Mr. Silva 1 Palm hat  
Mr. Taber 5 lbs Tobacco,  
108 lbs 20 Paid for yards 2 lbs.

Monday March 19<sup>th</sup>  
A.M. fair weather. P.M. some Rain. all hands went to the wreck of the Mantinomi and pick up an Anchor and 30 fms cable. took the Anchor to the ship. so ends.

Tuesday March 20<sup>th</sup>  
most part of the 24 hours cloudy unsettled weather, with Rain employed sawing splitting and stowing wood. got a Raft of 9 casks of water. also got 30 fms cable from the wreck, and 20 lbs game from shore.

Wednesday March 21<sup>st</sup>  
most part cloudy unsettled weather, with some Rain, employed variously got three Boat loads of wood.

Thursday March 22<sup>nd</sup>  
most part fair weather wind from the N.E. employed getting wood and water. got a Raft of 10 casks. also got 2 Boat loads of wood. without 2 Regt Powder.

Friday March 23<sup>rd</sup>  
all these 24 hours fresh breezes N.E. employed stowing wood and water. got off 4 Boat loads of wood, 5 lbs game. Painted 1 Boat. &c &c.

Saturday March 24<sup>th</sup>  
all these 24 hours smart breezes at N.E. and fair weather. employed sawing splitting and stowing away wood. Sorting over Potatoes, and various other jobs. our Potatoes rotting very fast. got 2 Boat loads of wood. opened 1st Beef Port.

Sunday March 25<sup>th</sup>  
most part cloudy and rainy weather. crew ashore in liberty. two Portuguese Deserted. Joe. and Manuel, also the tamaru Kanaka.

Monday March 26<sup>th</sup>  
most part of these 24 hours strong easterly winds. first part Rainy weather. got off 2 Boat loads of wood. Set up Dr. Stay, for Rigging and M. & M. Backstays. opened a Cask of Bread.

Tuesday March 27<sup>th</sup>  
all these 24 hours easterly winds and fair weather, employed fitting and Darning down Rigging. also Smoked Ship to kill rats.

Wednesday March 28<sup>th</sup>  
all these 24 hours fair weather, wind at N.E. employed taring Rigging, washing Ship &c. got two Boat loads of wood.
