Back No. 5, contains 2 S. staysails, 2. Royal, 2. D. S. sail, Block straps, 4 coils towline, 4 coils in a lead pipe, Cask No. 1 contains, old D. sail, 2. D. M. staysails, Mizzen topsails. Change the day for West longitude.

Studd. E. P.M. finished washing ship. A.M. Bickham & Pipes of water. Cleaned out the tank and filled it. took some Bone on deck.
