Monday Decr 10th

most part of these 24 hours fine weather,
all hands on board. employed Bundling and Drying
Cane, and at other jobs.

B. Burgess went on shore without leave and remains
there.

Tuesday Decr 11th

most part moderate trades. and fair weather,
all hands employed Bundling and Drying Cane
and other jobs.

Steward ashore on liberty.

Wednesday Decr 12th

all these 24 hours light and calm clear and fine
weather. all hands employed Bundling Cane.
P.M. finished Bundling the Cane
203 Bundles in all.

Thursday Decr 13th

all these 24 hours clear and fine weather.
employed washing ship and various other jobs.

Discharged most of the crewers.
Delivered 21 Cans to Capt N. S. Perkins

Friday Decr 14th

all these 24 hours clear and fine weather. employed
at various jobs. Sent down D. topmast and rigged
in jibboom. Both wanting bands.

Saturday Decr 15th

all these 24 hours clear and fine weather. employed
fitting D. topmast Backstays and Rigging.
B. Made a jib stay of one of the old backstays.

Sunday Decr 16th

fair weather throughout the day. most of the
crew on liberty. nothing worthy of notice.

Monday Decr 17th

most part cloudy unsettled weather. wind from the S.
employed at various jobs. Breakout for Shrouds and
Shank heads. P.M. sent up D. topmast.

Tuesday Decr 18th

most part moderate breezes and fair weather.
employed variously. Rigged out jibboom. Sent up
D. D. S. Mast. Cooper setting up Ropes.

Wednesday Decr 19th

fair weather throughout the day. employed at various
jobs. about the Rigging. Cooper setting up Shrouds

Thursday Decr 20th

fair weather throughout the day. got 8 Ropes water from
shore. Breakout After hold. found 16 Blk Cork, 1 Blk But
4 Casks Delmon, 5 Casks Mulafes, 1 Cask tawline.

Friday Decr 21st

variable winds and fair weather. employed at
various jobs. got off 6 Ropes water. Painted ship
farb side.
