Tuesday Jan^y 1st 1856
fair weather throughout the day,
all hands on liberty. Delivered 5 Boxes Soap
380 L.

Wednesday Jan^y 2nd
fair weather throughout employed variously
had four Caulkers caulking the Deck,
Red 12th for Powder - 15th for Barrels.

Thursday Jan^y 3rd
fine weather throughout the day, employed
variously, 5 Caulkers employed caulking Deck.

Friday Jan^y 4th
fair weather throughout employed variously
3 Caulkers half a day, 5 half a day.

Saturday Jan^y 5th
all these 24 hours Clear and fine weather,
employed at various jobs, the Caulkers
finished caulking the Deck, made 14 days work.

Sunday Jan^y 6th
most part of this 24 hours Cloudy and
stormy weather, wind from S.W.
half the crew on liberty.

Monday Jan^y 7th
most part fair weather, variable winds,
employed at various jobs. Bent a new
Fore topsail.

Tuesday Jan^y 8th 1856
fair weather throughout the day
employed at various jobs, nothing worth of notice.

Wednesday Jan^y 9th
moderate Breezes and fair weather throughout
the day, employed at various jobs.
Met hold fire and aft for the first time.

Thursday Jan^y 10th
fair weather throughout the day, wind from the
South, employed Caulking Stern fire and aft.

Friday Jan^y 11th
Strong Breezes from the Westward with some
Rain, employed at various jobs.

Saturday Jan^y 12th
most part strong Breezes from the Westward
Cloudy unsle weather, with some Rain.
Bent the Sails and wet hald.

Sunday Jan^y 13th
all these 24 hours variable wind and calm with fair
weather, most of the crew on liberty.

Monday Jan^y 14th
Variable winds and fair weather, employed at various
jobs. Recd from Shore 7 Bags Coffee, 1 Chest
of tea, 3 Coils Rope, 2nd 2nd 8 3 inch,
3 Pairs of Stockings.
