

Ship Mary Frazier Harbor of Honolulu, S. I. 1856.

Tuesday Jan 15th

Fair weather throughout the day most part
moderate breezes, employed at various jobs,
Red Bx Bx fish potatoes.

Wednesday Jan 16th

Fair weather throughout the day, A.M. light wind
and calm, unmoved and hauled out to the
outer harbor. Dredged Sails Anchor with
25 fms chain moved Stern to N.E. to a buoy.

Thursday Jan 17th

Fair weather throughout the day most part
moderate trades, employed variously,
Shipped several men. Steward came on board
to duty.

Friday Jan 18th

Fair weather throughout the day most part
southerly winds, employed variously,
Cook came on board to duty. So ends.

Saturday Jan 19th

Fair weather throughout moderate breezes and
calm, employed variously,
Red Bx Bx fish potatoes, Wet held ice.

Sunday Jan 20th

moderate breezes and fair weather throughout
most of the crew on liberty,
nothing more worthy of notice.

Monday Jan 21st

moderate southerly winds and fair weather,
employed at various jobs, so ends.

Tuesday Jan 22nd 1856.

most part fair weather, wind from the S.W.,
employed at various jobs. Red several articles
from shore, so ends.

Wednesday Jan 23rd

Fair weather throughout the day, wind from
S.W., employed variously, Wet held ice.

Thursday Jan 24th

most part of the day fair breezes from S. to
S.W. and some rain, employed at various jobs,
Discharged the Steward, and shipped the one
we had on the last cruise. He came on board
to duty.

Friday Jan 25th

moderately southerly winds and fair weather,
throughout the day, employed at various jobs,
got some articles.

Saturday Jan 26th

A.M. moderate breezes from the S. fine weather
at 3 P.M. took the steamer and towed out of the
harbour, left part fine breezes at S.W.
Shed off and on, so ends.

Sunday Jan 27th

A.M. light variable winds and calm, with fine
weather, shed off and on at Honolulu.
This day contains 2 hours.
