Monday Jan 28th 1856,
 all the 24 hours fresh Breezes from
 S.W. to S.E. at 7 P.M. Boat came off from
 shore. Middle part Steered S.E., all
 sail set. At 11 o'clock the Anchors and
 cables, at noon Cuyler in sight.
 Did 2000 Miles,
 Opened at 10 1/2 P.M.

Tuesday Jan 29th
 P.M. moderate Breezes from S.W. to N. Clear and
 fine weather. Steered S.E. by S. A.M. light
 variable winds and calm. employed at various
 jobs. took in Starboard Boat to Repair, Painted
 it. Boat. A.M. a stranger made his appearance
 on Board, a young man who reported that he had
 deserted from the Ship Charles Phelps, and
 concealed himself on Board the Mary Frazier.

 all the 24 hours moderate Breezes from E to
 S.E. with fine weather. Steered by the wind to
 the S. all sail set. employed at various jobs,
 wet hold 8 c.

 P.M. moderate Breezes from E to S.E. with fine
 weather. A.M. fresh Breezes at E. Steered by
 the wind to S.E. all sail set. employed at
 various jobs. set up F.T.M. Backstays and
 Rigging, and yet Guy's Carpenters Repairing Boat.

 all the 24 hours fresh Breezes from E to E.N.E.,
 Steered by the wind to S.E. A.M. hauled
 V.I. sails, set Main topmast Backstays and
 Rigging.

Saturday Feb 2nd
 all the 24 hours fresh Breezes from E to E.N.E.,
 and fair weather. Steered by the wind to S.E.
 employed at various jobs. fat 14. 01 N.
 Long 156. 05 W.

Sunday Feb 3rd
 fresh trades at E.N.E. throughout the day,
 with fair weather. Steered by the wind to S.E.
 all sail set. Middle part saw a sail heading
 to the N.
 fat 9. 38 N.
 Long 156. 18 W.

Monday Feb 4th
 all the 24 hours fresh Breezes from E.N.E. to
 N.E. by N. with fair weather. Steered by the
 wind to S.E. all sail set. employed at
 various jobs. put Starboard Boat out and Painted
 her.
 fat 7. 18 N.
 Long 152. 25 W.

Tuesday Feb 5th
 all the 24 hours fresh Breezes from E.N.E. to N.E. by
 N. with fair weather. Steered by the wind to S.E.,
