Remarks Thursday May 8th 1856.

Commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.E. and stormy weather. Steered N.E. Middle part wind from E. to N. latter part strong Breezes at N. by W. Clear weather. Steered by the wind to N.E. by E. turned out Rusk and set M.D.C. sail, employed Rattling & M. Rigging and various other jobs. fat 21" 20 S. long 35" 34 W.

Friday, May 9th

all the 24 hours fine Breezes from N.W. to W. Clear and fine weather. Steered N.E. all sail set, employed fitting, Riggging and various other jobs. opened Reef & Port. fat 19" 30 S. long 34" 17 W.

Saturday May 10th

all the 24 hours moderate Breezes from the West. Clear and fine weather. Steered N.W. E. all sail set. employed fitting, Riggging and at other jobs. fat 18" 24 S. long 33" 10 W.

Sunday May 11th

P.M. light airs from the N. Clear and fine weather. Steered by the wind to N.E. Middle part moderate Breezes at N.W. E. Tacked to N.W. M latter part smart Breezes from N.W. E. to N.W. at 10 A.M. Tacked to N.E. fat 17" 5 S. long by set 39" 50 W.

Monday May 12th

these 24 hours commenced with Strong Breezes from the S.W. and hard squalls. Steered N. Middle part moderate variable winds, latter part calm. Clear and very warm. employed Rattling & Riggging and various other jobs. fat 16" 50 S. long 34" 10 W.

Tuesday May 13th

P.M. light airs and calm. A.M. moderate Breezes at E. S.E. Clear and pleasant weather. Steered N. by E. all sail set, employed Rattling and fitting & Riggging and at various other jobs. I sail in sight. fat 16" 24 S. long by set 34" 20 W.

Wednesday May 14th

most part of the 24 hours fine Breezes from E. to E. S.E. Middle part squally. Steered N. by E. all sail set, employed fitting & Riggging. turned up M. topmast Backstays and various. fat 14" 14 S. long 34" 29 W.

Thursday May 15th

most part of the 24 hours fine Breezes at E. to E. by N. P.M. squally. A.M. pleasant weather. Course N. by E. employed fitting Riggging and at other jobs. fat 12" 0 S. long 34" 37 W.

Friday May 16th

fine Breezes at E. to E. S.E. Clear and fine weather. Steered N.W. E. employed fitting Riggging saw two sail. Broached a Ripe of Bread fat 9" 12 S. long 34" 18 W.
