Sunday June 1st

all these 24 hours smart trades at E.N.E. to E. and fair weather. Steered N.W. by N. all sail set. Saw Sooty Gull.

Monday June 2nd

all these 24 hours fine Breezes from the Eastward and fair weather. Steered N.W. by N. all sail set employed cleaning Starboard Chain Cable, and at various other jobs. A.M. saw several sail.

Tuesday June 3rd

most part of these 24 hours moderate Breezes from E.N.E. to E.S.E. with fair weather. first and middle part Steered N.W. by N. at 7 A.M. saw sperm Whales at 1/2 past 7 lowered the Boats. Gallied the Whales but did not strike at 1/2 past 11 Boats came alongside. Whales about 2 miles from the ship and getting slurr.
