

Ship Mary Drazier Bound towards home ¹⁸⁵⁶

Wednesday June 4th 1856.
all these 24 hours moderate breeze from the
Eastward clear and fine weather, at 1 P.M.
started after the Whales again. Struck and killed
one to L Boat, at 4 P.M. got him alongside,
got up the tables hoisted up 3 Pipes of water. Cleared
the Decks and got ready for cutting.
A.M. employed cutting. Two sail in sight one
of them took a Whale. fat 25.. 27 N
opened Beef & Pork. Long by 59.. 00 W

Thursday June 5th
all these 24 hours moderate breeze from the Eastward
clear and fine weather, at 2 P.M. finished
cutting. Middle and latter part employed boiling.
at 7 A.M. spoke Schooner E. Nicholson of Providence
town, 10 Mts out 350 Whale 140 sperm. Bound home
Capt. Freeman.

latter part sterd N.W. fat 25.. 14 N
Long 54.. 35 W

Friday June 6th
all these 24 hours moderate breeze from E.N.E.
to E.S.E. clear and fine weather.
Sterd N.W. and W.N.W. employed boiling &c.
fat 25.. 48 N
Long 60.. 37 W

Saturday June 7th
most part of these 24 hours fine breeze from E.N.E.
to E.S.E. clear and fine weather. first part
Sterd N.W. at 2 P.M. finished boiling.
Whale made 75 lbs. at 5 P.M. saw a wreck
Bottom up. it appeared to be a vessel of 3 or 4 hundred
tons. not coppered. Hull oak. Plank yellow
Pine. Lay by during the night.

Saturday June 7 Continued.
A.M. went to the wreck again. Discovered that
her Stern was all gone. Bowsprit also gone
supposed she had been wrecked several months.
latter part sterd N.W. by W. employed cleaning
sterd cable.

fat 26.. 13 N
Long 61.. 11 W

Sunday June 8th
all these 24 hours fine breeze from E to S.E.
clear and fine weather. Sterd N.W. and
N.W. by N. P.M. finished cleaning and
varnishing the cable. Saw nothing worth
notice.

fat 27.. 18 N
Long 62.. 45 W

Monday June 9th
all these 24 hours fine breeze at S.E.
clear and fine weather. Sterd N.W.
A.M. coopered the oil and stowed it between
Decks, 9 Pipes containing 76 bbls.
Turned in and set up jib Girts. fat 28.. 23 N
Long 64.. 27 W

Tuesday June 10th
all these 24 hours fine breeze at S.E. and
fair weather. Sterd N.W. employed
washing Ship inside and out for painting.
fat 29.. 30 N
Long 65.. 25 W

Wednesday June 11th
all these 24 hours fine breeze at S.E.
with fair weather. Sterd N.W. & W.
employed painting Ship inside and out.
Saw two Sail. fat 30.. 48 N
Long 66.. 40 W
