most part of the day calm. Clear and warm weather. heavy swell from N.E. employed at various jobs. two sail in sight.

first part light airs at N.W. fine weather. middle and latter part smart breezes from N.W. to N. Steered E. by S. middle part double reefed the topsails.

Sunday Oct 5<sup>th</sup>

first part moderate breezes at N.W. fine weather at all sail. Middle part calm. latter part fine breezes at W. Steered E. by S.

all these 24 hours smart breezes from N. to S.W. middle part squally handed the light sails. Steered E. S. E. A.M. set D. S. E. Back stay S.

all these 24 hours moderate breezes from N. to N. N. W. fair weather and smooth sea. Steered S. E. all sail set. saw nothing but Geampes. served out Molasses. quart a week. to a man.

Sunday Oct 12<sup>th</sup>

first part light breezes at N. N. W. Clear and fine weather. Middle part calm. latter part light breezes at S. E. hazy and overcast. Steered by the wind to the S.

Monday Oct 13<sup>th</sup>

first part moderate breezes at S. E. hazy and overcast. Steered by the wind on different tacks. Middle part calm. latter part fresh breezes from S. S. W. to N. S. W. Cloudy. Rainy unsettled weather. Steered by the wind to the S. at 4 A.M. double reefed the topsails. no obs. set by Act 30.. 25
