the Portuguese and Swabs had a Muff at the mid. at
Breakfast time as all hogs are apt to. Changed
the watches, put all dockages in one. and the
tagtags in the other.

Sunday Nov 2nd
all these 24 hours cloudy unsettled weather.
attended with rain. wind from S. to S. E. and
Calms. Stewd by the wind on different tacks.
saw a Bark to Seward. Lat 5° 30' N
Long 28° 37' W

Monday Nov 3rd
first part moderate backing wind and calm
cloudy with some rain. Middle and latter
part fresh breezes at S. S. W. backing clouds
and fair weather. Stewd by the wind to the S. W.
Lat 4° 23' N
Long 29° 43' W

Tuesday Nov 4th
all these 24 hours fine breezes at S. E. to E.
with fair weather. Stewd by the wind to S. S. W.
all sail set. saw a Brig steering N. Lat 2° 19' N
