

Round Towards, Cape Horn, Nov. 1856.

Tuesday Nov. 18th

first part strong Breezes at S.S.W. very rough sea, middle and latter part smart Breezes from S. to S.E. Course S.W. set all sail A.M. Broke out 4 1/2 lbs water, & Cask of Bread, Lunar 63 Miles W. Lat 20° 58' S. Long 37° 45' W.

Wednesday 19th

all the 24 hours fine Breezes from E. to N.N.E. with fine weather, Steered S.W. and N.S.W. A.M. set Balistays and some of head Rigging, Lat 22° 25' S. Long 39° 09' W.

Thursday 20th

all the 24 hours smart Breezes at N.E. Clear and fine weather, P.M. Steered N.S.W. A.M. Steered W. Lat 23° 10' S. Long 41° 40' W.

Friday 21st Commenced with fresh Breezes at E.N.E. at 10 A.M. saw Cape Horn, bearing N.W. Dist about 25 Miles. Middle and latter part moderate Breezes. Mostly Cloudy & overcast. Course S.W.

Chronometers differ from each other 4 1/2, and correspond very well with Cape Horn, Lat 24° 48' S. Long 43° 30' W.

Saturday 22nd

all the 24 hours moderate Breezes at N.E. mostly Cloudy & overcast. Steered S.W. all sail set. no ch. Lat by Alt 25° 30' S. Long 44° 20' W.

Sunday Nov. 23rd 1856.

all the 24 hours moderate Breezes from E. to S.E. Steered S.W. by N. saw several shoals of Grampuses, Lat 26° 56' S. Long by Chrt 48° 23' W.

Lunar 45 20 W

Monday Nov. 24th

most part moderate Breezes from E.S.E. to E.N.E. Clear and fine weather. Steered S.W. A.M. employed sheathing the Deck, Lat 27° 59' S. Long 46° 45' W.

Tuesday Nov. 25th

first part moderate, Breezes at E.N.E. middle part middle part fresh Breezes from N.E. to N. latter part much the same, Steered S.W. Lat 29° 21' S. Long 48° 09' W.

Wednesday Nov. 26th

P.M. moderate gale at S.S.W. at 3 double Ropes the topsails, hand jib & Mainsail, heading S.E. at 5 A.M. made ship to S.W. latter part moderate Breezes and Clear, Lat 29° 58' S. Long 49° 40' W.

Thursday Nov. 27th

all the 24 hours light variable winds and Calm, Rough sea, Steered to S.W. Lat 30° 14' S. Long 48° 05'

Friday Nov. 28th

most part fresh Breezes from E. to N.E. with fair weather, Steered S.W. P.M. sailed two humphacks, Lat 32° 05' S. Long 50° 00' W.

Saturday 29th

all the 24 hours light airs from N.E. & Calm. Course S.W. Lat 32° 48' S. Long 50° 27'
