middle part very rough sea, double Reefed the topsails  
banded Jib & Mainsail. Steered N.W. N.W.  
fat 53.12 S  
long 78.15 W

Thursday 8<sup>th</sup> first part fresh Breeze at S.W.  
fair weather. Steered N.W. latter part moderate  
Breeze

Friday 9<sup>th</sup> first and Middle part moderate Breeze

Middle and latter part moderate gale at N.W. Steered

Drizzly. Steered by the wind to the N.  
Caught 4 Porpoises

to N.W. very rough Steered by the wind on different  
tacks. AM. Spoke Ship Deloriday of N. Red pond  
3 Mts out 30 lbs sperm, fat by Act 38.50  
long 74.30
