May 28 all three hours moderate breeze and calm.
 Employed Boiling, saw nothing

Friday 29th fresh breeze at S.W. rough sea, lowered twice for
 Whales, without success. saw a Barataria two Whales

Saturday 30th A.M. fresh breeze at S.E. got a Whale to Boat,
 at 2 P.M. got him to the ship, latter part stowing down
 side, main hold

Sunday 31st A.M. fresh breeze and foggy, employed cutting
 spoke ship Coral of N. Bedford & Whale
 latter part employed Boiling,

Monday June 1st Most part fresh breeze at S.E. thick and foggy
 with some snow, steering by the wind under
 short sail, employed Boiling

Tuesday 2nd most part fresh breeze from N.E. to S.E. thick and foggy
 weather, steered by the wind under easy sail,
 employed Boiling
 Lat 56. 47
 Long 142. 25.

Wednesday 3rd fresh breeze from the Eastward and northeast,
 employed Boiling.

Thursday 4th fresh breeze from S.E. to E. thick and foggy,
 steered by the wind on different tacks. 7 ships in sight
 A.M. saw the gun to the S. employed stowing down

Friday 5th fresh breeze at S.E. A.M. moderate and foggy
 saw one sail

Saturday 6th most part moderate breeze from Westward
 and hazy, steered up to the lee. saw two ships
 no whales.

Sunday 7th Most part fine breeze from S.W. to S.E. fair weather
 steered to S.W. A.M. saw 8 ships
