 light breezes from the S. steered by the wind on different tacks. Thick saw the land occasionally.

Sunday  
 22<sup>nd</sup>  
 first part light airs from S. middle and latter part had the N.E. trades. Thick Raining unsettled weather at 1 P.M. Arrived off Hills.

Monday  
 23<sup>rd</sup>  
 moderate trade and calms with thick Raining unsettled weather. A.M. went on shore to Ascertain if i could ship oil & Bone. found i could not. at 6 P.M. got on Board. at 6 Calm was compelled to Anchor in soft mud water. at 7 light breeze drove on. got under way. at 8 soon fell calm at 10 Anchored in soft mud. ends with thick Raining smooth light airs and calm.
