Thursday the 23 of Oct
this day commences with fine breezes
from the SE saw a large Ship steer-
ing to the North Sundown light wind
from the SE pump Ship Middle part
Saw a large Ship later part saw
a large Steam Ship steering to
the Westward also two other vessels
bound to North
this ends the 30 day and a month

Lat 21 35 N Long 34 07 W Course full and by

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Friday Oct 24
this day commences with a fine breeze from
the E SE saw a Brigantine bound to the
North sundown the same Middle part
there was a row in the fore-castle between
the Portuges and Americans a man by
name gumby struck a Portugee by name
Antone Haker and another one by name
Tom H. Kinsman later part fine breeze
from the E
this ends the 31 day

Lat 19 00 N Long 33 28 W Course S S E

Oct the 25 Saturday
this day commences with a strong breeze
from the E sundown the same pump
Ship Middle part fine breeze later
part the same saw a large Clipper Ship
English and a Brig bound to the North
this ends the 32 day

Lat 17 05 N Long 32 29 W Course S S E

Sunday Oct the 26
this day commences a fine breeze from the
E at 2 PM passed a French Ship
bound to the North Sundown fine
breeze pump Ship Middle part the
same later part saw a Ship and Bark
both Clippers steering to the North also
a fine breeze from the Eastward
this ends the 33 day
