Oct the 27 Monday
This day commences with a fine breeze from the Eastward sundown the same pump Ship Middle part fine breeze later part the same saw two finbacks caught two Bonitas hands employed at various work this ends the 34 day

Lat 12 35 N Long 30 22 W Course S by E

Tuesday Oct the 28
This day commences with fine breezes and pleasant weather saw a large Sulphurbottom also a Ship bound to the Northward sundown fine breeze from the E pump Ship Mid part fine breeze later part saw two finbacks also a fine breeze from the Eastward set up the fore Topmast Topgallant and Royal Backstays this ends the 35 day and 5 fath

Lat 10 20 N Long 29 21 W Course S by E

Wednesday Oct the 29
This day commences with fine weather and fair wind from the Eastward set up the main rigging and the Main Topmast and Topgallant stays Sundown the same pump Ship Mid part moderate breeze later part rain squalls this ends the 36 day

Lat 08 23 N Long 28 00 W Course S

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Thursday Oct the 30
This day commences with light airs and calms from the SE sundown calm pump Ship Mid part calm later part moderate breeze from the N attended with rain squalls no observations this ends the 37 day

Lat 07 41 N Long 28 46 W Course S

Friday Oct the 31
This day commences with the wind from the N and heavy rain caught 3 casts of rain water at 4 PM cleared up and saw a Brig also caught four Skypack Sundown fine breeze from the Eastward pump Ship Mid part calm and squalls later part fine breeze from the Eastward large shot of Alboree around the Ship this ends the 38 day

Lat 06 50 N Long 28 30 W Course S by E

Saturday Nov the 1
This day commences with a heavy rain squall at 2 PM cleared off and calm Sundown rain squall no wind pump Ship Mid and later parts rain squalls with light winds from the Southward took out one bark of Bread this ends the 39 day
