Thursday Nov the 20

This day commences with moderate breezes from the N.E. and fine weather. Sundown the same pump. Ship Charles Tashure of duty sick with a bulo in the ground. Mid part lay aback 3 hours. Later part strong breeze from the N.E. This ends the 58 day.

Lat 23 07 S Long 41 38 W Course W and W by S

Friday Nov the 21

This day commences with strong breezes from the E.N.E. one sail in sight at 2 P.M. made Cape Frio bearing about N.W. by W. Sundown strong breeze from the duty sick with a bulo. Mid part calm. Later part light breeze from the N.E. This ends the 59 day. Course S.W.

Saturday Nov the 22

This day commences with light airs from the N.E. caught a large Dolphin 4 1/2 feet long. Sundown light airs pump. Ship Charles Tashure of duty sick with a bulo. Mid part light. Later part the same opened one Barrel of Beef and one of Pork. This ends the 60 day.

Lat 25 30 S Long 44 20 W Course S.W.

Tuesday Dec the 1

This day commences with a strong breeze from the N.E. saw a large number of finbacks. Sundown the same Cooper off duty sick also Charles Tashure with a bulo in the ground. Mid part the third hauled to the N. strong breeze later part the same saw a number of finbacks and Humpbacks. This ends the 70 day and 10th Week. Course S by W.

Lat 38 10 S Long 50 30 W

Wednesday Dec the 3

This day commences with strong breezes and rain from the N. Sundown the same the Cooper on duty again Charles Tashure off duty sick with a bulo in the ground at 8 o'clock P.M. the wind hauled to the S.E. and blew fresh took in all sail but the Main Top sail close reefed. Fore topmast stay sail and Main spencer down the night and later part a severe gale from the S.E. Course made W by S.

Lat 38 53 S Long 52 11 W

Thursday Dec the 4

This day commences with a severe gale from the Southward attended with heavy rain squalls. Charles Tashure off duty sick with a bulo in the ground. Cooper also off duty sick at 6 P.M. wore ship and headed S.E. by S. Sundown moderated a little set the Fore spencer Mid part moderate some and made sail. Later part strong breeze from the W.S.W. This ends the 72 day. Course by the Wind.
