23

Saturday Nov the 29

this day commences with moderate winds from the Westward sundown calm pump Ship Charles Tashure off duty sick with a cold and later part lights winds and calms

this ends the 27 day

Lat 32 48 S Long 50 21 W Course S W

Sunday Nov the 30

this day commences with light airs and calms from the S & at 3 o'clock P.M. Sounded and got 55 fathoms of water Sundown the same Charles Tashure off duty sick with a cold in the ground tack Ship and anchor stood on the Eastern tack mid and later parts the same the third S

this ends the 28 day

Lat 33 28 S Long 50 18 W Course by the Wind

Monday Nov the 31

this day commences with strong breezes from the S saw two Ships standing to the Westward at one P.M. tack Ship at 3 P.M. the wind hauled to the S E Sundown the same Charles Tashure off duty sick with a cold in the ground mid part the wind hauled to the S E with a strong breeze later part the same saw a large number of porpoises the Cooper off duty sick cold weather

Lat 35 18 S Long 50 08 W Course S

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Friday Dec the 5

this day commences with a strong breeze from the Westward at 1 P.M. double reefed the Topsails sundown the same Charles Tashure off duty sick with a cold mid part a moderate Gale of Wind later part a severe Gale from the W S W laying too on the Starboard tack

this ends the 25 day

Lat 40 32 S Long 51 41 W Course by the Wind ^{supposed}

Saturday Dec the 6

this day commences with a severe gale from the W S W attended with heavy hail squalls Sundown a little more moderate Charles Tashure off duty sick with a cold in the ground mid part Gale later part moderate made Sail

this ends the 26 day

Lat 40 31 S Long 51 26 W Course by the Wind on both tacks

Sunday Dec the 7

this day commences with a moderate breeze from the Westward at 4 P.M. saw two large Sperm Whales going to the Windward lowered the boats but did not get on one of them saw the Ship and got galled Sundown moderate breeze from the S W Charles Tashure off duty sick with a cold mid part a Gale from the S W later part the same

this ends the 27 day

Lat 41 25 S Long 51 13 W Course S W
