this day commences with a fine breeze
from the Westward several Sail
in sight sundown the same
Charles Tashere and the Cooper
of duty sick one with the pox
and the other with lazyness
mid part light winds later part
calm this ends the 99 day
and the last of 1858

Thursday Jan the 1 ¹⁸⁵⁹
this day commences with light
airs from the S Sundown
strong breeze Charles Tashere
and the Cooper off duty sick
mid and later parts moderate
the winds from W to SW
this ends the 100 day

Friday Jan the 2
this day commences with fine
breeze and pleasant weather
from the Westward sundown
the same Charles Tashere and
the Cooper off duty sick
mid part calm later part strong
breeze from the Eastward
this ends the 101 day

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Saturday Jan the 3
this day commences with strong breeze
from the Eastward and thick weather
Sundown the same the Wind from
the SE Charles Tashere and the
Cooper off duty sick mid part strong
breeze from the SW later part
light from the SW
this ends the 102 day

Sunday Jan the 4
this day commences with light airs on caling
from the SW Sundown the same one
Ship in sight Charles Tashere and the
Cooper off duty sick mid part light
winds and more squalls later part the
same see the English Bark Island Mary
from calic bound to Cork put letters on
board of her
this ends the 103 day

Lat 5711 S Long 72 42 W Course W N W

Monday Jan the 5
this day commences with moderate breeze
attended with snow squalls from the
SW Sundown the same Charles Tashere
and the Cooper off duty sick mid part
strong breeze from S to SW later part
from the SW
this ends the 104th day
