1857

Tuesday Jan the 6th
this day commences with strong breezes
from the SW sundown the same
Charles Tashure off duty sick with
a tubo the cooper off duty also
sick with cold weather mid part
strong breezes from the SW
at 11 o'clock tacked Ship and stood
the SW later part strong breezes from
SW at 4 AM tacked back to the NW
thus ends the 105th day
Course made NW 1/2 W

Lat 35 00 S Long 75 10 W

Wednesday Jan the 7th
this day commences with strong
breezes from the SW sundown
the same Charles Tashure off duty
with a tubo the cooper also off
duty sick mid part strong breezes
from the S later from the
SW
thus ends the 106th day

Lat 33 12 S Long 78 26 W Course NW

Thursday Jan the 8th
this day commences with a fine
breeze from the WSW Sundown
the same Charles Tashure and
the cooper off duty sick mid part
fine breezes from the W to the SW
saw a large Ship bound to the S later
part light breezes from the W
thus ends the 107th day

Lat 30 58 S Long 79 30 W Course N 1/2 W

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Friday the 9 of Jan
this day commences with light wind and
pleasant weather from the Westward
put out the West Bont Sundown the same
Charles Tashure and the cooper off duty
sick mid part press breezes from NW
caught two Porpoises later part from
the SW caught three Porpoises
thus ends the 108th day

Lat 49 48 S Long 77 08 W Course NE

Saturday Jan the 10th
this day commences with strong breezes
from the N at 3 o'clock PM tacked Ship
Sundown the same Charles Tashure and
the cooper off duty sick mid part strong
breezes from the N later part from the
SW
thus ends the 109th day

Lat 49 27 S Long 78 30 W Course N

Sunday Jan the 11th
this day commences with strong breezes
from the N Sundown the same
Charles Tashure and the cooper off
duty sick mid and later strong
breezes from the N with fog and rain
thus ends the 110th day

Lat 48 44 S Long 75 59 W Course NE
