Monday Jan the 12th
this day commences with strong
breezes from the North fog and
rain sundown the same Charles
Tashure and the cooper off duty
sick. Mud and later part a gale
from the NW
thus ends the 111th day

Tuesday Jan the 13th
this day commences with strong
breezes from the Westward sundown
the same Charles Tashure and the
cooper off duty sick. Mud and later
parts strong breezes from NW
to W caught 5 Porpoises
thus ends the 112th day

Lat 47 00 S Long 67 50 W

Course NW E

Wednesday Jan the 14th
this day commences with fine breezes
from the WNW sundown the
same Charles Tashure on duty
the cooper off duty sick. Mud
and later parts strong breeze from
the Westward
thus ends the 113th day

Lat 44 46 S Long 76 50 W

Course NW E

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Thursday Jan the 15th
this day commences with a strong breezes
from the Westward sundown the same
under short sail looking for Whales
Mud and later parts strong breeze from
the W spoke the Bark Favorite of Fairhaven
38 months out 1000 bbls of oil
thus ends the 114th day

Lat 43 42 S Long 75 00 W

Course NW E

Friday Jan the 16th
this day commences with strong breezes from
the W gaining with the Bark Favorite sundown
the same the cooper off duty sick. Mud and
later parts moderate gale from the
Westward the Bark Favorite in sight
thus ends the 115th day

Lat 42 32 S Long 75 38 W

Course NW E

Saturday Jan the 17th
this day commences with strong breezes from
the W sundown more moderate the
cooper off duty sick. Mud and later
parts moderate breezes from the Westward
brook out Provosts and Water

Lat 41 20 S Long 75 00 W

Course NW E
