1857

Jan the 18th
this day commences with moderate
breezes and fine weather from
the Westward sundown the same
saw land on the coast of Chile
the Cooper off duty sick. Mid part
light breezes from the NW later
part strong breezes from the S
thus ends the 117th day

Monday Jan the 19th
this day commences with strong
breeze from the S W sundown
the same the Cooper off duty sick
Mid and later part strong
breezes from W to S W
thus ends the 118th day

Lat 39 36 S Long 73 59 W

Tuesday Jan the 20th
this day commences with strong breeze
from S W to S at 4 o'clock P M
saw the land on the coast of
Chile sundown the same
the Cooper off duty sick Mid
and later part moderate breeze
from the S
thus ends the 119th day

Wednesday Jan the 21st
this day commences with calm and
rain sundown the same the Cooper
off duty sick Mid part moderate breezes
from S W later part moderate gale
Spoke the Ship Florida of New Bedford
Capt Fish
thus ends the 120th day

Thursday Jan the 22nd
this day commences with a moderate gale
from the W S W Sundown more
moderate the Florida close to us the
Cooper off duty sick Mid part moderate
later part light airs from the S W
running in for the land in company with
the Ship Florida
thus ends the 121st day

1859

Friday Jan the 23rd
about 11 o'clock the Second Mate fell on
the deck in a fit whilst looking through
the glass at the land previous to this time
he as had two other fits when in his berth
he was quite sensible during the fits
this day commences with light breezes
from the westward running with
the Ship Florida Capt Fish sundown
calm the Cooper off duty sick Mid
part calm later strong breezes from the
S the Island of Mexico in sight the
Ship standing in for the land
about 11 o'clock the Second Mate fell
down on deck in a fit
thus ends the 122nd day
