Saturday Jan the 24
this day commences with strong breezes
from the S E the Ship laying off
and on Mocha Sundown the same
Mr Philips off duty also the Cooper
off duty sick. Mud and later parts
laying off and on the Wind S
thus ends the 123 day

Sunday Jan the 25
this day commences with strong breezes
from the S laying off and on
Sundown the Capt came on board
and stood to the N W the Cooper
off duty sick. Mud and later parts
strong breezes from the S the
Ship Florida in sight
thus ends the 124 day

Lat 36 28 S Long 75 35 W Course N W by W

Monday Jan the 26
this day commences strong breezes
from the S sundown the same
the Cooper off duty sick. Mud and
later parts strong breezes from
the S W at midnight Mr Philips
had another fit which lasted about
an hour
thus ends the 125 day

Lat 34 05 S Long 77 40 W Course N W by W

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Tuesday Jan the 27
this day commences with strong breezes
from the S gunning with the Ship Florida
of New Bedford Sundown the same the
Island of Juan Fernandez in sight the
Cooper off duty sick. Mud part lay with
the main yard aback later part stood in
for the land in company with the Ship
Florida and sent one boat in a fishing
thus ends the 126 day

Lat 33 36 S Long 78 45 W Course N W by W

Wednesday Jan the 28
this day commences with strong breezes
from the S spoke the Ship Napoleon
of New Bedford gunning with the Florida
Sundown the same the Cooper off duty
sick. Mud and later parts fine breezes
from the S E repairing Fore Top sail
thus ends the 127 day

Lat 32 34 S Long 80 17 W Course N W by W

Thursday Jan the 29
this day commences with fine breezes
from the S E Sundown the same repaired
the Fore top galant sail the Cooper off
duty sick also Mr Philips and Capt
Mud and later parts fine breezes from
the S E repaired the Fore Sail
thus ends the 128 day
