

Journal of the Ship Mary Grazier of New Bedford 1853

Friday April the 3
this day commences with fine breezes from the S at 6 PM got under weigh and left harbor for Oahu mid part strong breeze from S daylight saw the Island of Oahu about 10 miles dist bearing NW later part strong breeze from the S
thus ends the day

Saturday April the 4
this day commences with strong breezes from S at 1 o'clock the Capt went on shore sundown squally the wind WSW the Capt came on board and steered to the S mid and later parts calm Oahu in sight to the S
thus ends the day

Lat 21° 45' N Long 157° 22' W Course S

Sunday April the 5
this day commences with light breezes from SE sundown the same four ships in sight also the Island of Oahu mid part light winds mid calm from E later part fine breezes from S
thus ends the day

Lat 21° 18' N Long 159° 15' W Course W

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Monday April the 6
this day commences with fine breezes from the S sundown the same the Capt unwell with a fever and the decker Mid and later parts calm and rain squalls took in the Mast Boat and repaired her
thus ends the day

Lat 21° 02' S Long 159° 39' W Course W by S

Tuesday April the 7
this day commences with Calm and rain squalls sundown the same the Capt unwell with a fever Mid part rain later part light air from E
thus ends the day

Lat 21° 13' S Long 160° 41' W Course W by S

Wednesday April the 8
this day commences with light air from SE repairing jib and painting Boat also took out provisions sundown light breezes from SW saw some Grampuses Mid and later parts light breeze from the E
thus ends the day

Lat 21° 13' Long 161° 58' W Course W by S
