Saturday June the 14th
This day commences with moderate breezes from ESE saw a Whale lowered the saw him no more sundown fog and rain mid part the saw Later part steering breezes from the SE saw nothing steering to the SW this ends the day

Sunday June the 15th
This day commences with strong breezes from NE sundown the same with fog and rain steering to the SW for the land saw nothing at 3 PM took Ship of shore mid part strong breezes from NE and rain later part gale and rain from NE the Ship heading to the Eastward this ends the day

Monday June the 16th
This day commences with a gale from the NE and rain sundown the same mid part moderate from NE later part the same at 3 AM saw the land about 20 miles dist bearing NE lowered two Boats and went in shore saw a California Gray this ends the day

Tuesday June the 17th
This day light breezes from NE at 2 PM lowered the Bow Boat and went in shore the other two Boats on shore saw nothing sundown thick fog lost the Ship and went in shore for the night at 8 AM saw the Ship 20 miles off and started for her at noon got on board this ends the day

Wednesday June the 18th
This day commences with light aces from the NE one Ship in sight at 6 AM spoke the Ship Concord of New Bedford bound to San Francisco for repairs had got stove in the Sea mid and later part strong breezes from ESE and thick snow storm the land in sight about 10 miles dist this ends the day

Thursday June the 19th
This day commences with thick snow storm the wind from ESE sundown more clear saw the Island of St. John bearing SE 12 miles dist mid part clear later part bound to the S saw Six spoke the Ship Charles W. Morgan of New Bedford & Whales this season this ends the day

New Bedford Capt John Rounds Cohasset Sea 1857

Friday June the 20th
This commences with light breezes from NE lowered three Boats and went in the Sea saw nothing sundown came on board gained with the Ship C. W. Morgan mid and later part calm in the SW bay this ends the day

Saturday June the 21st
This day commences with light breezes from the ENE sundown the same mid and later parts strong with thick fog and rain at 5 AM saw Sugar loaf Island took Ship stood to the SE at 10 AM saw the Main land this ends the day

Sunday June the 22nd
This day commences with fog and rain strong breezes from NE at 3 PM saw a Bark at anchor to the Westward sundown more moderate and clear mid and later parts strong breezes and thick fog from NE this ends the day

Monday June the 23rd
This day commences with strong breezes and fog saw the land at 5 PM took Ship sundown the same mid and later parts the same this ends the day

Tuesday June the 24th
This day commences with strong breezes and thick fog from NE mid part the same at 5 AM saw the land about one mile dist later part the same this ends the day

Wednesday June the 25th
This day commences with strong breezes and fog at 5 PM saw a Ship to the Westward sundown a gale from the NE mid part more moderate later light from NE saw two Ships to the NE saw the land this ends the day

Thursday June the 26th
This day commences with light breeze and fog sundown the same saw the land mid and later part calm this ends the day
