Friday June the 27

this day commences with light breezes from E saw the Hunter Pelagos and Bare Islands bearing from E to S sundown the same Mid and later parts light breezes from E to Ships in sight this ends the day

Saturday June the 28

this commences with light breezes from E spoke the Bark Fortune from the N E gulf dead saw one Whale this season and the Ship Empire one Whale this season Mid and later part light breezes from the E the land in sight this ends the day

Sunday June the 29

this day commences with light breezes from the E to the N E lowered two Boats and went in shore to look for Whales at 8 P M thick fog fired half cag of Powder for the Boats on shore at 6 P M cleared the land about 4 miles off at 9 P M saw the Boats came on board had seen nothing mid part strong breezes from the N at 10 A M saw the Island of saw the top much off saw two Ships later part calm this ends the day

Monday June the 30

this day commences with light airs and calms spoke the Bark Warren and the ship Ontario with four and six Whales this season the Ontario got a Whale that dead that took our line he had no line on him at the time they took him on from broke and other one got sundown the same the Island of Belcher in sight bearing N W about 10 miles distant Mid and later parts calm this ends the day

Tuesday July the 1

this commences with calms and fog saw two Ships herd a Whale mid heard 3 later one fog and calm this ends the day

Wednesday July the 2

this day commences with light breezes from N E saw 6 Ships and the land nearly around us sundown Moderate breezes and fog and Ice to the N Mid and later parts calm and fog saw two Ships this ends the day

Thursday July the 3

all this 24 hours calm and fog saw the Ship Mary of Edgartown this ends the day

Friday July the 4

this day commences with light breezes from E saw 8 Ships spoke Bark Philip the 1st of Goldspring 5 Whales this season sundown moderate breezes and rain Mid and later calm spoke the Ship Sagadia 2 Whales and the Ship Harry 1 Whales this season this ends the day

Saturday July the 5

all this 24 hours calm and fog heard Whales saw one did not lower gunning with ships Harry and Sagadia this ends the day

Sunday July the 6

this day commences with calms and fog mid and later parts the same this ends the day

Monday July the 7

this day commences with calms and fog Mid part the same later part the wind from the W and clear two Boats went into the sea and saw from 20 to 25 Whales this ends the day

Tuesday July the 8

this day commences calm and clear 7 Ships in sight at anchor and 3 under sail sundown the same the Boats come on board Mid and later parts calm and fog this ends the day

Wednesday July the 9

this day commences light breezes and clear from N E brook but provision at 2 P M came to an anchor about 6 miles from round Island bearing N E by N at 9 the cannon anchored 1 mile from us mid and later fog breezes from N E this ends the day

Thursday July the 10

this day commences fog sundown the same breezes from N E Mid and later parts calm and clear went on shore on round Island and 3 Boats load of Wood and dried bone this ends the day
