

Journal off the Ship Mary Fraser of

Wednesday Sept the 22

this day commences with light breezes from the N stormy oil mid and later parts calm the boats in shore no Whales this ends the day

Thursday Sept the 23

this day commences with calm sundown saw two Whales going quick mid part calm later part strong breezes from the N E this ends the day

Friday Sept the 24

this day commences with strong breezes from the N E mid and later parts the same no Whales this ends the day

Saturday Sept the 25

this day commences moderate breezes from N E mid part calm later part strong breeze from N started for Foulis Harbour to get wood and Water spoke the Ship Bonaditch 950 this season no Whales this ends the day

Sunday Sept the 26

this day commences strong breezes from the N sundown Anchored in Foulis Harbour later part getting wood and Water this ends the day

Monday Sept the 27

this day getting wood and Water Tuesday the 28th the same this ends 2 days

Wednesday Sept 29 the Steward of duty sick

this commences with a gale from N W already for mid strong from N W later part calm but wild looking weather the Barometer very low at 11 AM breezes up in strong gale from the N this ends the day

Thursday Sept the 30 this day commences strong breeze from the N E to N repairing fore sail mid part the same later part a gale from N E N W

Friday Oct the 1 this day commences with heavy gale from the N W dragged the anchor some at 2 PM let go the Spritsail Anchor at sundown more moderate the Ship Jan Wood came up to an anchor under close reefed M Ship sails mid

Friday Oct the 13

and later parts the same this ends the day

Saturday Oct the 14 this day commences with a gale from the N W at sundown more moderate mid part light from the N later part got moderate breeze bound out between Foulis and Big Shanty light airs from the Westward this ends the day

Sunday Oct the 15 Monday

this day commences with light air and calm from the N E at sundown Anchored again in Foulis Harbour could not get out mid part strong breezes from the N E later part a heavy Gale this ends the day

Tuesday Oct the 16 Monday

this day commences with a severe gale from the N E the Ship dragged her Harbours Anchor let go the Harbours Anchor wreck brought her up at sundown heavy hail squalls mid part moderated later part light breezes and fine weather this ends the day

Wednesday Oct the 17

this day commences with calm sundown light breezes from the Westward at midnight it blew a smart gale from W let go the Harbours Anchor the Ship started to drag later part moderated some took the Anchor and went out to sea between the Big Shanty and Foulis Island in company with three other Ships the Ship Jan Wood South Seamen and the Jan Wood this ends the day

Thursday Oct the 18

this day commences with strong breezes from the Westward sundown the same three Ships in sight Foulis about 8 miles East the N E head blowing N mid part calm later part a moderate Gale from the N this ends the day

Friday Oct the 19

this day commences with a strong breeze from the N Ship under double reefed Topsails sundown moderate mid and later parts the same stormy to S E no Whales this ends the day
