this day commences calm Sundown light breezes from S & E and part strong from S & E later part the same from S & E with rain this ends the day

Sunday Oct the 31st

this day commences with strong breezes from S & E Sundown a moderate gale with rain the ship under loose reefed topsails and spencers A mid part the wind hauled S W later part back to S & E and E with rain this ends the day

Monday Nov the 1st

this day commences with the wind hauling to the the Westward sundown moderate breezes S W and later part strong from W S W
Lat 44 40 N Long 168 30 E this ends the day

Tuesday Nov the 2nd

this day commences with strong W S W winds sundown the same mid part S W later part S & E the ship under single reefed topsails this ends the day
Lat 43 39 N Long 176 42 E course E & S

Wednesday Nov the 3rd

this day commences with strong breezes from S & E with the rain Sundown hauled the W with Thunder lightning and rain squalls mid and later part strong W winds at 3 A M three Portugues got to fighting one of the three got stabbed with the thigh they made part on to Major Bigham for punishment it being somewhat cold with jackets off and keep their one hour

Saturday Nov the 6th

this day commences with moderate breezes from S W washing bone sundown the same

mid part the later part calm and squall mended the main topsail this ends the day
Lat 35 20 N Long 163 10 W course E & S

Sunday Nov the 7th

this day commences with light breezes S to E mid and later parts the same mended the fore topsail this ends the day

Lat 34 09 N Long 162 08 W S & E by E & S course

Monday Nov the 8th

this day commences with moderate breezes from S & E sundown strong from S with rain squalls mid part from S & E later part from S & E to S Steward of duty still cannot find out his

this day commences with fine breezes from S & E Sundown the same mid and later part from S & E to S Washing Bone this ends the day
