at 9 PM came to Anchor again could not get  
out and later parts calm and rain  
this ends the day

Wednesday Nov the 25  
this day commences with calm sun down the  
same at midnight light breeze of the land got  
under weigh daylight Harbour about 10 miles off shore  
SW later part moderat breeze from eastward  
Lat 20 11 N Course SW this ends the day

Thursday Nov the 26  
this day commences with fine breeze from E sun down  
the same SW point of Hawaii bearing W S W about  
20 miles Dist Maui in sight Mid Part the  
same Lat part Arrived safe at Lahaina  
Maui this ends the day

Thursday Nov the 26 this day commences with  
the Capt going on shore before we came to anchor  
at 5 PM sent of word for me to anchor the  
Ship which I did the 2 Mut and cooper whist  
on shore also the Cook Friday the 27 this day  
braking out the upper hold and stowing  
oil in the ground tier Saturday the 28th  
Shipping Bone per Ship carpenter Howland of  
and for New Bedford the Amount Ship 11435 lbs  
the No of Bundles 119 one hundred marked B F H  
also numbered from 1 to 100 composed to J B F  
Howland Sunday the 29th all hands with the  
exception of 6 on Liberty Monday the 30th  
landed 31 Bbls for Sale stowing oil in the upper  
hold and cooking meat Tuesday the 31st  
washing Ship and setting up Shocks for received on  
board one Boat load of Sweet potatoes sent a raft of  
cask on shore for Mut 2 Wednesday Dec the 1st  
this day got of a raft of Water one Watch on  
Liberty stowing Water in the upper Hold landed  
5 Bbls of Shuck for Sale Thursday the 2 this day  
painting Ship one Watch on Liberty Friday the 3rd  
painting received on board 500 pounds of Beans  
Saturday the 5th received on board 15 bbls of Shuck  
potatoes painting Ship one Watch on Liberty  
Sunday the 6th all hands on Liberty for next three  
Deserters on board landed them on shore

Monday the 7th landed 2 cask and one Turee of  
Whale oil containing 253 gallons also 2 boxes of tobacco  
cask on shore for Water Tuesday the 8th took  
on board a raft of Water also 2 bbls Shuck stowing  
Water in the main Hold Wednesday the 9th  
took on board a raft of Water also received 30 bbls of  
Shuck potatoes and got aboard for sea Thursday the 10  
setting up the Sackstye fore and aft Discharged the  
Sheward two Men Described Charls Yashure and Thucator  
Taylor Friday the 11 this day came on board 4 Natives and  
one Chinaman also Received 400 lbs of beans and Sunday small  
articles the quantity of Beef received on board 880 lbs  
at Noon the Cooper came on board  
this ends the last day in  
Lahaina
