this day commences with strong breezes from ESE
sundown the same with sharp lightening. Mist part
fine later rain. Storm with the wind from the E
no observations
thus ends the day
Cruising

Monday Feb the 1
this day commences with a heavy storm the wind from
E to SE and later parts fine from SE Brought a
new Main Top Sail making Spangarn mats for Chafing
gear Splicing Bow Boats Deck. thus ends the day
Lat 13 22 N Long 46 19 W Cruising

Tuesday Feb the 2
this day commences with fine breezes and fine weather
from SE at 6 PM a fight in the Forecastle the Puncable
Actors Robt Carroll and Sandwich Islander was punished
by sending one the Spanker from the other on the Spanker
Yofft Mist part later parts strong breezes from SE with
Rain Squalls
thus ends the day

Lat 14 35 N Long 47 33 W

Wednesday Feb the 3
this day commences with strong breezes from SE steering
SW Bound to Huahine I believe at 5 PM saw Franz Island
Mist part lay too day light steered to the WSW much
Krusenstern Island it is not in its proper position on
on the chart being layed down to far to SE
thus ends the day

Lat 14 45 N Long 48 42 W course W

Thursday Feb the 4
this day commences with fine breezes from SE at 2 PM
made Lazareff Island at sundown about 6 miles East
to the S Mist part say too with heavy yards about daylight
steered to the SW later part strong breezes from ESE
thus ends the day

Lat 15 55 N Long 49 50 W course SW

Friday Feb the 5
this day commences with strong breezes and squally with
Rain Mist part laying too thunder lightening and Rain
Daylight steered to the SW at 8 PM saw Huahine Is. at
56 miles bearing SW by W but the chains at 11 AM saw
Blackpink lowered the Bow Boat took one
thus ends the day

Lat 16 34 N Long 50 11 W course SW

Capt John Rounds between seasons 1858
Saturday Feb the 6

this day commences with fine breezes from E at
sundown Huahine about 4 miles East bearing S W
hailed on the Wind on the Northern side. Mist
part tucked with a strong breeze from the SE daylight
steered to the S saw the Land at 8 PM took a Pilot at 11
Anchored in the Harbour
thus ends the day

in the Port of Huahine
Sunday Feb the 7

this day commences Draping out Water and getting
a raft on shore to remain there untill we get ready
for it as we are going to drop our old all hands
on Liberty Monday 8 coopers oil Tuesday the 9th the
same Wednesday the 11th the same got through
coopers Thursday the 11th got a raft of Water one
Watch on Liberty received some pork on board
Stowing Water Friday following Water landed some
White Pine Lumber and other Goods one Watch on
Liberty Saturday the 13th one Watch on Liberty got
Snack raft of Water received on board 10 lbs of
Sweet Potatoes 2600 Oranges and some Bananas
by Mary Deserret Samuel Jupp and Richard Hanson
Sunday the 14th all hands on Liberty caught the
two men that Deserret Monday the 15th all ready for
Sea thus ends this chapter on Huahine

Tuesday Feb the 16th
this day commences with getting underway with
light breezes from SE sundown the same
steering to the SE Mist and later parts fight from
SE Huahine in sight Dist 35 miles bearing S by E
thus ends the day

Lat 16 14 N Long 51 40 W course S by W
