Wednesday Feb the 17

this day commences light breezes from ESE painting
Lar Boat sun glow squally Mist and later parts
fine from ESE to SE the West Boat saw
a large Bruce about 10 miles off

this ends the day
Lat 15 24 S Long 151 30 W course N by E
Thursday Feb the 18

this day commences with fine Breezes from ESE
day a Bruce and nothing more. Mist part heavy
thunder and lightning with the wind from all
around the compass later part light from E
this ends the day

Lat 14 50 S Long 151 00 W course ESE
Friday Feb the 19

this day commences with light air and calms
Mist and later parts the same painting Lar Boat
and cleaning from Work for painting
this ends the day

Lat 14 25 S Long 151 23 W

Saturday Feb the 20

all this 24 hours calm painting West cleaning
the main channel turning the Fore stay
this ends the day

Lat 14 28 S Long 151 30 W

Sunday Feb the 21

this day commences with calm and catpaws from all
around the compass Mist and later parts the same
this ends the day

Lat 14 45 S Long 151 23 W

Monday Feb the 22

this day commences with light air from ESE sundown
fine Breezes with Rain squall Mist part light later
part strong with Rain no observations
this ends the day

Tuesday Feb the 23

this day commences with strong Breezes from SE
with Rain it is a double reefed the Top Sails split
the Flying Jib Mist and later parts Mist erate
with Wind from ESE and later parts flying jib
and cleaning the chains the Capt. sick with fever
this ends the day

Lat 13 00 S Long 150 45 W

Wednesday Feb the 24

this day commences with light breezes from ESE
sundown the same the Capt has a severe fever
this evening Mist and later parts light from ESE
this ends the day

Lat 12 07 S Long 151 43 W

Thursday Feb the 25

this day commences with light breezes from ESE the
same better to day Mist and later parts light from
SE painting this ends the day

Lat 11 41 S Long 150 34 W

Friday Feb the 26

this day commences with calm sundown the same
Capt Round better Mist and later parts light
from SE to ESE painting from Work

this ends the day

Lat 11 41 S Long 150 25 W

Saturday Feb the 27

this day commences light breezes from SE sundown
the same with Rain squally Mist and later the
same this ends the day

Lat 11 19 S Long 150 13 W

Sunday Feb the 28

this day commences with light breezes from E opened
a bag Black parrot Mist part light later part strong
Breezes from SE this ends the day

Lat 10 46 S Long 150 22 W

Monday Feb the 29 March the 1

this day commences with strong Breezes from SE
at 4 PM passed Caroline Island did not see it do not
think it is there. Mist and later parts Moderate
Breezes from SE to ESE

this ends the day

Lat 9 13 S Long 150 24 W

Tuesday March the 2

this day commences with moderate Breezes from SE
Mist part the same later part strong from
the SE repairing flying jib
this ends the day
