

Journal of the Ship Mary Frazier of
Tuesday June the 15 this day commences with
strong breezes and thick fog scattering ice around
sundown the same but part cleared up later part
the same ice to the S & ships in sight
this ends the day
Lat 55 00 N

Wednesday June the 16 this day commences with light
breeze from SE to at 3 PM made the Island
of Renchikoff bearing SW by S about 20 miles Dist
at sundown 15 miles Dist plenty of ice and 3
ships in sight to the SE mid and later
fine saw the main Land on the Sagalean
Side also Renchikoff Island this ends the day
Lat 54 55 N

Thursday June the 17 this day commences with
light breezes and fine weather saw the ships
Corea and Olympia sent 3 boats in the ice
saw nothing at 7 PM came on board sundown
the same Renchikoff Island bearing SW
10 miles Dist mid and later part calm and fog
took the Harbour Anchor on deck and sent a
smaller one this ends the day

Friday June the 18 this day commences with light
breezes from SE at sundown strong breezes and
clear mid and later parts strong breezes and thick
fog double reefed Top sails this ends the day

Saturday June the 19 this day commences with strong
breezes and thick fog sundown the same mid
part moderate later part calm and fog
this ends the day

Sunday June 20 this day commences calm at sundown
light breezes from the E spoke the Ship Walter
Scott of Edgartown had taken 900 lbs of oil in the
voyage mid part moderate later part steady
breezes thick fog this ends the day

New Bedford Capt John Round in Chiotok
Monday June the 21 1858

this day commences with strong
breezes and thick fog double reefed Top sails sundown
the same mid and later parts the same
this ends the day

Tuesday June the 22 this day commences with moderate
breezes from ESE and thick fog sundown the
same mid part light later part the same at
sundown cleared up saw the Island of Proctopp bearing
WNW 15 miles Dist all full off ice to S this
this ends the day

Lat 55 00

Wednesday June the 23

this day commences with fine
breezes from E spoke the bark Delaware of
New London Capt Round went on board sundown
strong from E and clear weather 3 ships in
sight mid and later part strong breezes and
thick fog from SE this ends the day

Thursday June the 24 this day commences with strong
breezes and thick fog sundown the same mid and
later part moderate and thick fog steering ESE
this ends the day

Friday June the 25 this day commences with light
breezes and fog from SE sundown the same
mid part clear later part thick fog sounded and
got 50 fathoms of water this ends the day

Saturday June the 26 this day commences with light
breezes from SE cleared up some saw two ships and
Lat N to the SW sundown calm and thick fog
mid and later part calm at 10 PM cleared up
Lat 55 15 N this ends the day

Sunday June the 27 this day commences with light breezes
from W saw 4 ships also the Island of Proctopp
Menschikoff and Round Island sundown light from
SE mid and later parts fine from SE saw Land
to the S also Proctopp and Menschikoff and Round
Islands this ends the day
Lat 55 58 N
