

Journal of the Ship Mary Frazier of New Bedford
sundown fine breeze from S & E 1858

Laying to under easy sail for the night
thick part moderate from S & E to S E later
part strong breeze from and thick weather
at 11 1/2 M saw Rankin Island bearing S by W
Dist 18 miles Tehakotan bearing N 25 miles
this ends the day

Lat 48 34 N Long 153 20 E Course Made S & E
Saturday Oct the 30

this day commences with strong
breeze from S & E to E at 1 PM lost sight of
Tehakotan at 4 PM steered to the Westward Capt
Round did not think it advisable to go through
in the night at 5 1/2 PM Rankin Island bearing
S & E 5 miles Dist at 6 PM hauled on the wind
to the Northward under easy sail for the night
thick part moderate breeze from S & E later part
part from N at 10 AM passed Rankin Island
at noon bearing N 25 W 18 miles Dist
this ends the day

Lat 48 25 N Long 154 15 Course E by S
Sunday Oct the 31

this day commences with fine breeze
from NNE at 2 PM passed the Trap or Sister
Rocks 12 miles Dist bearing N sundown fine
breezes from NNE thick part strong from N
later part light and calm Coopering Cal
this ends the day

Lat 47 50 N Long 156 45 E Course E by S
Monday Nov the 1

this day commences with calm
at 4 PM light breeze from S & E heading S & E
unbent and staved the cables thick part strong
breeze from S & E at 4 PM doubled reefed Topsails
later part the same with rain
this ends the day

Lat 48 06 N Long 160 40 E Course E by N
Tuesday Nov the 2

this day commences with strong breeze
from S & E at 6 PM moderated Rainy thick part moderate
and later strong breeze from W
this ends the day

Lat 48 13 N Long 162 30 E Course E

Capt John Round's passage to NW Islands
Wednesday Nov the 3

this day commences with strong
breeze from W at 5 PM doubled reefed the
Topsails a moderate gale from W. thick and
later the same this ends the day
Lat 47 11 N Long 166 55 E Course E & S

Thursday Nov the 4
this day commences with a moderate
gale from W at 6 PM from WNW moderating thick
part fine breeze later part light from W to NW
this ends the day

Lat 46 03 N Long 170 12 E Course E & S
Friday Nov the 5

this day commences with calm
unbent the main topsail and bent another one
at 6 PM moderate breeze from S & E thick part come
on a moderate gale with rain from S & E
at 8 1/2 PM the wind hauled to the W later
part the same clear weather this ends the day
Lat 46 22 N Long 171 55 E Course E by S
Saturday Nov the 6

this day commences with strong
breeze from W sundown the same thick and
later parts fine breeze from W to WNW
this ends the day

Lat 45 08 N Long 175 20 E Course E & S
Sunday Nov the 7

this day commences with fine
breezes and fine weather from W at sundown
the same thick and later parts the same with
rain squalls this ends the day

Lat 43 06 N Long 178 46 E Course S by E

Monday Nov the 8
this day commences with fine
breeze from WNW sundown the same thick
and later strong breeze with smart hard squalls
from WNW this ends the day
Lat 42 56 N Long 177 55 W Course E by S
large time

Monday Nov the 8
this day commences with strong
breeze from WNW sundown the same
thick part from W later part from WNW with
severe rain squalls this ends the day
Lat 41 31 N Long 174 10 W Course E by S & S
