Tuesday Nov the 9

this day commences with strong breezes from W. Split the fore topsail at sundown the same with squalls mid and later part breezes and fair weather from W. W. unbet the foretopmast and bent another one this ends the day
Lat 40 30 N Long 171 55 W Course E by S
Wednesday Nov the 10

this day commences with fine breezes from N. W. repaired the main topgallant sail bent a new flying jib at sundown the same mid part fine breezes later part light from N. W. sent down the foretopgallant mast found it sprung in the topmast cap this ends the day
Lat 39 20 N Long 168 40 W Course E by S
Thursday Nov the 11

this day commences with light breezes from N. W. at sundown from W. sent up the foretopgallant mast mid part light from E. Later part strong breezes from E. N. E. with rain at 10 A. M. Double reefed topmasts and purchased the main sail no observations this ends the day
Friday Nov the 12

this day commences with a moderate gale from N. E. at 2 P. M. took in the foretopmast and jib also the foremast mid part a severe gale took in the main topmast wench hauled to the N. W. at 8 P. M. kept away to the S. E. later part a gale from N. E. W. this ends the day

Saturday Nov the 13

this day commences with a gale from N. W. at sundown moderate mid part light breezes from W. to S. W. later part sent aloft the foretopgallant yard strong breezes from S. this ends the day
Lat 36 19 N Long 166 20 W Course S by E
Sunday Nov the 14

this day commences with strong breezes from S. at sundown from S. E. Double reefed topmasts mid part a gale from S. E. later part strong breezes from W. this ends the day
Lat 35 20 N Long 163 20 W Course E by S

Monday Nov the 15

this day commences with fine breezes from W. N. W. at sundown the same mid part moderate breezes from N. to N. E. later part the same bent the foretopgallant sail this ends the day
Lat 34 11 N Long 161 44 W Course S by E by E
Tuesday Nov the 16

this day commences with light breezes from N. E. got the whale bone on deck already for washing sundown fine breezes from E. mid and later parts from S. E. to E put the row boat on the crane this ends the day
Lat 32 35 N Long 161 37 W Course made S
Wednesday Nov the 17

this day commences with light breezes from E. N. E. washing bone sundown the same mid and later parts light airs from N. W. this ends the day
Lat 31 54 N Long 160 59 W Course E by S
Thursday Nov the 18

this day commences with light airs from W. N. W. washing bone sundown from S. W. mid part light from S. W. to S. E. later part calm this ends the day
Lat 31 35 N Long 161 20 W Course S by E
Friday Nov the 19

this day commences with calm washing bone sundown light breezes from S. mid and later parts light breezes from S. to S. E. fine weather this ends the day
Lat 31 32 N Long 159 45 W
Saturday Nov the 20

this day commences with light breezes from S. E. finished washing bone sundown the same mid and later parts from S. to S. E. drying bone this ends the day
