

Journal of Ship Mary Frazier of 1858

Monday Jan the 31

this day commences with calm and heavy swell
run into Sun down Hawee in sight to the N.E.
Mid part later part moderate and variable winds
the Land 6 to 10 Miles Dist. setting up the
Lower Rigging this ends the day

Tuesday Feb the 1

this day commences with light breezes and calms
Mid part strong breeze from N. later part
at 10 A.M. saw Blackfish and lowered for them
without success from Mainmast Rigging
Calm off Kibulu on ship in sight
this ends the day

Wednesday Feb the 2

this day commences with calm sun down spoke
the ship Montezuma of New London Mid part
moderate later part calm fitting Rigging Capt
Cook of the Maria Thruwa came on board
the Land about 10 Miles Dist
this ends the day

Thursday Feb the 3

this day commences with strong breeze from N.
punch the Mast boat Mid part strong later
part the same fitting a new Starboard Boat and
fitting Rigging the Land about 8 miles Dist
this ends the day

Friday Feb the 4

this day commences with strong breeze from N.
spoke the Bark Spruce (Cruz) Mid part
moderate from N.W.W. later part the same
Cruising of Hawee this ends the day

Saturday Feb the 5

this day commences with moderate breeze from
N. to N.W.W. Mid part calm later part light breeze
from N. fitting Rigging and about the Land about 10 miles
Dist this ends the day

Sunday Feb the 6

this day commences with moderate breeze from N.W.
Mid part light breeze from S later part the
same the Land 20 miles Dist this ends the day

New Bedford Capt John Bourne 1858

Monday Feb the 7

this day commences with light airs and calms
Capt Hazard of the Manuel Ortiz came on
board Mid part light breeze from S later part
the same repairing Harbour Boat and fitting
Rigging the Land 20 miles Dist
this ends the day

Tuesday Feb the 8

this day commences with calm mid part moderate
breeze from N.W. to S Mid and later part calm
repairing Bow Boat and fitting Rigging the Land 20
miles Dist this ends the day

Wednesday Feb the 9

this day commences with light breezes from N.W. painted
the Mainmast and Harbour Boat Mid and later
light and calm the Land 15 miles Dist
this ends the day

Thursday Feb the 10

this day commences with calm repairing Bow Boat mid
part the same and cloudy later part at moderate
Rain storm the Wind light from E.W.N. and S
this ends the day

Friday Feb the 11

this day commences with a moderate Rain storm with
light winds from N. to S Mid and later part
the same this ends the day

Saturday Feb the 12

this day commences with Rain storm at 5 P.M. cleared
up Lower saw the Land about 15 miles Dist
to the N.W. Mid and later part Rain Rain Rain
with light airs all around the compass
this ends the day

Sunday Feb the 13

this day commences with calm and Rain Mid and
later the same the 25 or 30 miles Dist to the N.
this ends the day

Monday Feb the 14

this day commences moderate breeze from N. at 6 P.M.
the Land 6 miles Dist to the N. Mid part Rain later
part strong breeze Double reefed Topsails with Rain
this ends the day
