Sunday Feb the 27

this day commences with moderate breeze from E to SE at 4 PM Capt Rouns came on board and put laying off and on at daylight keep away to the Westward in company with Maurice Ortiz later part moderate and cloudy this ends the day

Monday Feb the 28

this day commences with moderate breeze from E and later parts the same but breaking out water took the anchors on the bows unben't the cables and stowed the ... this ends the day

this day commences with moderate breeze and fine weather mid and later fine breeze from NE fitting rigging repairing old Harbour boat and Old Sails this ends the day
