Monday March the 14

This day commences with fine breezes from N^WE
obtained Lunar observations which gave the Long of 178-14
E 13 miles to the Eastward of the Chronometer 178-01-30
Shorten Sail and Lay by the Wind all night W^W
Kinsman & Long Coopers duty having no Cooper on
board Later part moderate from E^WE saw
Sundown this ends the day

Tuesday March the 15

This day commences with moderate breezes from E^WE
sundown Shorten Sail and Lay aback all night
Later part light collected 600 fathoms of new Towline
this ends the day

Wednesday March the 16

This day commences with moderate breezes from E^WE
Sundown Shorten Sail and Lay aback
Later part strong from E^WE
this ends the day

Thursday March the 17

This day commences with strong breezes from E^WE
hauled to the N^W sundown Shorten Sail
and Lay moderate from E Later part same
from E^WE this ends the day

This day commences with light breezes from E^WE
sundown Shorten Sail and Lay aback all
night later part light from E^WE repaired the
Spanker setting old oil Shooks
this ends the day

This day commences with light breezes and Sun
at 4 PM the wind hauled to E and clear weather
and part Lay aback later part fine breeze
from E^WE setting up Cal Shooks
this ends the day

Sunday March the 20

This day commences with fine breezes from
E^WE Sundown Shorten Sail and Lay part
moderate at daylight saw a Sail to S^W
Later part light from E^WE
this ends the day

Monday March the 21

This day commences with light breezes from
E^WE at 2 PM spoke the Ship Hannah Theresa of
New Bedford and jammed with her sail part fine
breezes and later part the same
this ends the day

Tuesday March the 22

This day commences with fine breezes from
S^W and part calm and later part the
same this ends the day

Lat 24 35 N Long 168 40 E Course S^W

Wednesday March the 23

This day commences with calm and part breeze
from N^WE later part the same strong
this ends the day

Lat 23 18 N Long 167 52 E Course N^W by N

Thursday March the 24

This day commences with strong breezes from
N^WE and part the same at 10 AM hauled on
the wind with the head yard aback later part
strong breezes with rain squalls
this ends the day

This day commences with strong breezes from N^WE
at 6 PM Doubble reefed the Top Sail and part
Lay aback later part strong Trade winds
this ends the day
