

Journal of the Ship Mary Frazier 1859
Saturday August the 20

This day commences with moderate breeze from S to S.W. at 3 P.M. calm at 5 P.M. breeze from S.E. cloudy weather at 7 P.M. Anchored about 8 miles W. from Eagle Point. Much part severe thunder and lightning with heavy squalls. Later part fine weather. Got underweigh saw a few Whales working Westward. Sailed without success. This ends the day.

Sunday August the 21
This day commences with light breeze S to S.E. at 7 P.M. Anchored 4 miles S.E. from Elbow Island at 8 P.M. severe squalls from N.W. with thunder and lightning. Later part fine weather. Got underweigh and started to reach the N. Shore. This ends the day.

Monday August the 22
This day commences with light breeze from N.E. at 3 P.M. thick fog at 4 P.M. Anchored. Much part thick fog. Later part strong breezes and rain from N.W. got underweigh stood over and made the N. Shore. saw nothing. This ends the day.

Tuesday August the 23
This day commences with moderating at 7 P.M. calm. Anchored about 8 miles from shore. saw two Whales. Much and later light breezes from S.W. steering to the N.E. sent 3 boats in shore. This ends the day.

Wednesday August the 24
This day commences with calm at 5 P.M. the boats came on board. had sun nothing. Much light breezes from N.E. Later part strong breezes and rain from E to N.E. This ends the day.

Thursday August the 25
This day commences with strong breeze and rain from S.W. at 5 P.M. saw the about 2 miles East to the N.W. Much part moderate and calm. Later part strong from S.W. Working to the N.E. This ends the day.

Friday August the 26

This day commences with strong breeze from S.W. at 4 P.M. saw a Whale the land 5 miles East to the N.W. Much part moderate later part light breeze sent off the boat to cruise along the shore. This ends the day.

Saturday August the 27
This day commences with light breeze and calm from S. One ship in sight at 5 P.M. the boat came on board. had sun nothing. Much part light breeze from S.W. to N.E. Later part from S.W. with rain. The Port of Arm Dist 20 bearing N.E. This ends the day.

Sunday August the 28
This day commences with moderate breeze from N. with rain at 2 P.M. came on a smart gale from N. split the foremast foretopmast and foretopmast staysail at 4 P.M. moderating. Sailing to under a close reefed M.J. sail and spencers. Much part more moderate. Later part light breezes from N. sent fore top sail and foresail and foretopmast staysail. Saw bearing N 15 miles East. This ends the day.

Lat 56 13 N Long 139 00 E
Monday August the 29
This day commences with fine breezes from N. to N.W. Much part light. Later strong from N.W. and cloudy spoke the Barque Alice of Colob Spring the land 5 miles East to N.W. course N.E. This ends the day.

Tuesday August the 30
This day commences strong breeze from N.W. to N. Much part calm. Later light breezes and calm. Lat 57 45 N Long 140 00 E. This ends the day.

Wednesday August the 31
This day commences with light breezes from S.W. at 3 P.M. saw 3 Whales in shore sent off 3 boats saw 1 Whale at 7 P.M. came on board. Much and later part moderate breezes and calm. saw a Whale and sailed without success. This ends the day.
