Friday Oct the 28

This day commences with strong breezes from N.E. at 6 P.M. settled to the N.W. with part moderate later part light from N.W. This ends the day

Lat 46 03 N Long 175 20 E

Saturday Oct the 29

This day commences calm making a new foremast yard out of an old foremast. Mist and later parts light from S.E. to S.W. and so ends the day

Lat 46 55 N Long 176 08 E

Sunday Oct the 30

This day commences with light breezes from S.E. and cloudy weather. Mist and later part the same one ship in sight. This ends the day

Lat 46 56 N Long 177 26 W

Sunday the 30 Oct

This day commences with light breezes from E to N.E. and fine weather. Mist part moderate later part strong breezes from E to S.E. This ends the day

Lat 46 41 N Long 178 01 W

Monday Oct the 31

This day commences with strong breezes from E to S.E. at 6 P.M. a moderate gale from S.E. Mist part the same later part more moderate. This ends the day

Lat 47 20 N Long 176 29 W

Tuesday Nov the 1

This day commences with strong breezes from E to S.E. Mist and later part a moderate gale from E to S.E. and so ends the day

Lat 48 02 N Long 177 55 W

Wednesday Nov the 2

This day commences with a moderate gale from E to S.E. at 6 P.M. laying too under close reefed main topsail and spinnakers. Mist part the same later part more moderate. This ends the day

Lat 47 01 N Long 177 10 W

Thursday Nov the 3

This day commences with strong breezes from E to S.E. Double reefed top sails and courses. Mist part strong later part moderate with fog squalls from E. This ends the day

Lat 48 40 N Long 176 03 W

Friday Nov the 4

This day commences with moderate breezes and thick fog from E broke out water. Mist and later part light breeze from N.E. to S.W. This ends the day no observation. Course E by S

Saturday Nov the 5

This day commences with light breezes from N.W. at 6 P.M. N.W. part moderate later part strong breezes from S.E. This ends the day

Lat 47 48 N Long 174 20 W

Sunday Nov the 6

This day commences with strong breezes from E to S.E. at 4 P.M. increases to a moderate gale. Mist part the same later part. Laying too under a close reefed N.E. sail. a gale from E with rain. This ends the day

Monday Nov the 7

This day commences with a moderate gale from E to S.E. with rain at 6 P.M. set the fore sail moderating. Mist part calm later part light breeze from E with thick fog. This ends the day
