Sunday Nov the 21

this day commences with strong breezes from ESE with smart squalls at 5 PM Double reefed. Topsails Waking home ship part strong later part more moderate close the last

Lat 26 14 N Long 158 45 W Course S

Monday Nov the 22 this day commences with strong breezes from ESE at 7 PM and later part the same

Lat 24 15 N Long 159 15 W Course S by W

Tuesday Nov the 22

this day commences with strong breezes from ESE at 7 PM tacked ship and heaved to at midnight tacked ship and heaved to by E later part Moderate from ESE part the Marching gate was

Lat 23 06 N Long 159 35 W Course S by W

Wednesday Nov the 23 this day commences with moderate breezes from ESE and one ship in sight at 6 PM saw the land bearing S by E and later part moderate breezes from ESE at noon the land in sight bearing ESE and anchor bearing S 30 Miles Dist

Lat 22 25 N Long 159 23 W Course S by E

Thursday Nov the 24

this day commences with moderate breezes from ESE and the Fore Topmast yard sprung on new one Mast and later part strong from ESE and later part in sight

Lat 22 39 N Long 159 20 W

Friday Nov the 25

this day commences with fine breezes from ESE at 6 PM the middle part of the day bearing S by E 12 Miles Dist Mast and later part light the land 20 Miles Dist

Saturday Nov the 26

this day commences with light breezes from SE at 8 PM the E end of Hawaii bearing S by W 18 Miles Dist Mast and later part light from SE at noon Hawaii bearing S by W 31 Miles Dist this ends the day

Lat 22 34 N Long 158 45 W

Sunday Nov the 27

this day commences with calm at 2 PM took a Run Squall from NW which lasted 2 hours at 6 PM calm later part calm off Duty sick Mast and later part calm

Lat 22 23 N Long 158 10 W

Monday Nov the 28

this day commences with light breezes from NW got the harbor anchor off the bow at 6 PM the Island of Oahu in sight bearing S by E 40 Miles Dist Mast and later part light breezes from NW at noon the S by W end of Oahu bearing S 8 Miles Dist this ends the day

Lat 21 00 N

Tuesday Nov the 29

this day commences with light breezes from NW at 6 PM off Pearl River the city of Honolulu 12 Miles Dist bearing S by E Mast and later part calm at 8 AM Capt Round went on shore at Honolulu saying off and on this ends the day

Wednesday Nov the 30

this day commences with light breezes from NW at 6 PM the boat came on board Mast part light saying off and on at 7 PM took boat at 8 AM Arrived in Honolulu towed in by the steam tug
