Thursday Feb the 9

This day commences with calm showing down Sperm  
Oil showed 78 bls in the Fore Hold at 4 P.M. saw  
Dean's Island bearing N 1/2 S 15 Miles Dist. Mast part  
Calm later part light from N.E.

Lat 44 51 S Long 147 15 W  
and so ends the day

Friday Feb the 10  
This day commences with light breeze from N.E.  
and fine weather Mast and later parts the same  
and so ends the day

Lat 44 39 S  
Saturday Feb the 11

This day commences with light breeze from N.E.  
at 2 P.M. made Dean's Island bearing N.W. Mast  
and later parts light breeze and Rain squalls  
from E. at noon Dean's Island bearing from  
S to W 14 Miles Dist. This ends the day

Lat 44 50 S  
Sunday Feb the 12

This day commences with light breeze from N.E.  
with Rain squalls at 5 P.M. Dean's Island 15 Miles  
Dist. S.W. Mast and later parts strong breeze  
from E.W. and so ends the day

Lat 44 25 S  
Monday Feb the 13

This day commences with strong breeze from  
E.W. saw Blackfish going to the N.E. Dean's  
Island at 6 P.M. 12 Miles Dist. to S. Mast and

Lat 44 21 S  
Tuesday Feb the 14  
This day commences with moderate breeze from  
E. at 7 P.M. Dean's Island 12 Miles Dist. to the  
S.W. Mast part later part strong breeze  
from N.E. Dean's Island 15 Miles Dist. at  
noon to the S.W. This ends the day

Wednesday Feb the 15

This day commences with strong breeze from  
N.E. Run down along the shore at 4 P.M. and  
passed a Harbour and village saw about 12  
houses and one Schooner in the Harbour at  
6 P.M. hauled off shore saw a another Schooner  
under full Mast and later parts calm clearing  
out the pump well the pumps being choked  
and so ends the day

Lat 44 38 S  
Thursday Feb the 16

This day commences with light breeze from N.E.  
to N.W. Mast part calm later part light from  
N.E. showing down Sperm Oil in the Fore Hold  
and so ends the day

Lat 44 49 S  
Friday Feb the 17

This day commences with light breeze from N.E.  
Dean's Island 12 Miles Dist. to the S.E. finished  
showing down Oil showed in all about 148 bls  
of Sperm Mast part light later part fine  
breeze from E. and so ends the day

Lat 44 29 S  
Saturday Feb the 18

This day commences with fine breeze from  
E to E.S.E. at 6 P.M. Foxen Island  
10 Miles Dist. to the S. Mast and later parts  
light breeze from N.E. and so ends the day

Lat 44 40 S  
Sunday Feb the 19

This day commences with fine breeze from N.E.  
at 6 P.M. Dean's Island 12 Miles Dist. to the S.  
opened a Store of Beef Mast and later parts  
strong from N.E. with heavy Rain squalls at 8 P.M.  
Dean's Island to the W. point bearing E. 2 Miles Dist. kept  
off to Westward at 10 P.M. off Krukenstein's Island saw  
a breach at noon made out Sperm Wives  
This ends the day
